

STATEMENT OF RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES

W.S. 22-25-106 through 109

Filing Office: County Clerk

Who must file: Each candidate and candidate's committee is required to file campaign finance reports within the statutory deadlines, whether the candidate is successful or not. This includes candidates who neither receive nor spend any money during the campaign. A committee formed before or after an election is required to file a statement of receipts and expenditures after each election. In an odd-numbered (non-election) year, any PAC or candidate committee which has previously filed a statement of receipts and expenditures and has not filed a statement of termination is required to file an annual itemized statement of receipts and expenditures.

What must be filed & when: According to WS 22-25-106(b)(i), a candidate/committee shall file an itemized statement of <u>receipts</u> at least seven (7) days before the election current to any day from the eighth day up to the fourteenth day before the election. The candidate/committee shall file <u>a statement of receipts and expenditures</u> within ten (10) days *after* a primary, general or special election. A committee formed after an election to defray campaign expenses incurred during a previous election, and any ongoing committee, shall file an itemized <u>statement of receipts and expenditures</u> on December 31st of each odd-numbered year and shall continue to make the reports until the committee terminates.

Reporting requirements: The general rule is that a candidate/committee should note and keep track of all campaign contributions no matter how small. The law only requires you to itemize contributions (receipts) on this form that total \$25 or more. However, keep in mind that if you receive \$10 from a contributor who then later gives you \$20, you must report the total \$30 contribution on this form.

Penalty for not reporting: A person found guilty of violating Wyoming campaign finance statues is subject to criminal charges.

Filing Deadlines

Primary Election: Receipts & Expenditures – within 10 days after the Primary: Aug. 29, 2014

General Election: Receipts & Expenditures – within 10 days after the General: Nov. 14, 2014

Non-Election Year (odd-numbered year) – Receipts & Expenditures: Dec. 31st

Special Election: Receipts & Expenditures – within 10 days after the election
